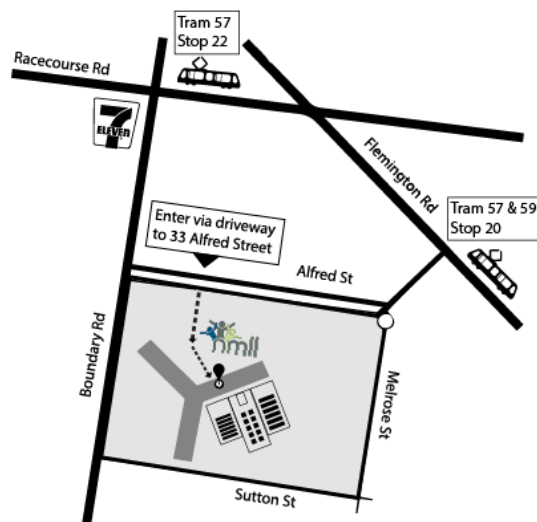

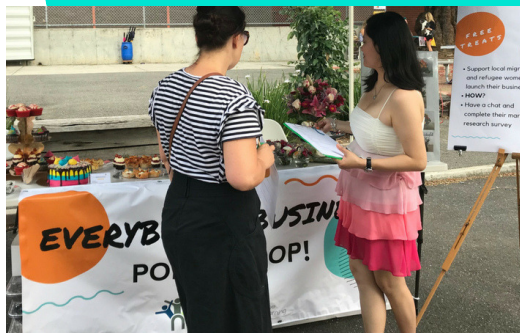

Mentoring

Participants are matched with volunteer
business mentors after the course to
keep the momentum going.

Business Support

Various types of business support are
offered to participants to help further
develop business skills. We also offer a
monthly 'pop-up' market shop to test
products and meet customers.
Monthly catch-ups keep participants
engaged and supporting each other.
