

THE PROJECT

NMLL works with a diverse migrant and refugee population hailing from 27 countries. Many people have asked for assistance to start small businesses as a way to create a job and generate income. Everybody's Business Project is NMLL's response. It compromises a course, specialised business support and practical business experiences.

English helps

To be considered for this course you need to have a good level of English comprehension with an intermediate level of English proficiency.

Mentoring

Participants are matched with volunteer business mentors after the course to keep the momentum going.

Business Support

Various types of business support are offered to participants to help further develop business skills. We also offer a monthly 'pop-up' market shop to test products and meet customers.

Monthly catch-ups keep participants engaged and supporting each other.
